paper mixology

Mix and match patterned papers like a pro! BY KELLY GOREE

Our resident paper mixologist is here to help you break it down, cut it out and make it work.

From home décor to clothing to scrapbooking, Hove bold, colourful styles. "The more colour the better," is my motto! But it can be really tricky to manage a lot of bold colour all in one place, especially on a scrapbook layout's small canvas. To tame a group of bold colours and patterns, I have discovered that framing or matting the trimmed papers with a neutral colour (such as black or tan) will give you something to balance out the bold and unify a hearty combination of colours. Here are a few easy tips to help you keep colour front and center on your pages, yet keep them under control.

- Plan your design. Establish the main elements of your design that you'd like to highlight or emphasize. Better yet, start with a sketch and draw out where you'd like them to go. A linear design works best for this technique.
- elements you'd like to highlight with a coordinating piece of cardstock, using the same colour for all elements. I prefer black or brown to really make the papers pop.
- **Give it that punch.** Select a few elements as accents to span some of the blocks in your design and to add texture and interest.

Don't be shy. Use these new-found blocking tips to work bold colours and patterns into your next design!

Although Xelly's primary neutral colour was black, she also introduced a few blocks of a dark teal to further unify her page.

Summer made quick work of converting this 12"x12" single sketch to a two-page layout. She extended all of the paper elements found on the sketch over to the right-hand page, then repeated several design elements on each side. She added two more photos, broke her title into two parts, and all of that creative effort resulted in a well-designed holiday page.



be merry & bright

sketch conversion tips

- **X** A quick and easy conversion technique is to choose a single page sketch and mirror the design onto a double page layout. With a few minor adjustments, you'll have a great design in no time.
- ₩ An 8.5"x11" double sketch can easily be converted to a 12"x24" double page by simply extending the drawn elements of the original sketch.
- ₩ Study a group of single page sketches and find two that look good side-by-side. Flip and/or rotate one or both of the sketches until you've established a double page design that you love.
- ₩ If you are a single page scrapbooker, an 8.5"x11" sketch easily converts to 12"x12". Simply design the 8.5"x11" page, adhere it to a 12"x12" base, and extend a few elements onto the foundation for a cohesive look.





multiple photo tips

- ₩ Convert several of your photos to black and white, leaving the "storytelling" photos in colour.
- **#** Premade pockets and paper bags are so popular right now (check out pages 10-11 of this issue) and both embellishments create a great place to tuck away additional photos.
- **X** Use a digital template in Photoshop, Photoshop Elements or Picasa to create a photo block collage.
- **X** When you have a lot of photos from the same event, choose one or two as your large, focal photos, then reduce the remainder of the photos to a smaller 2"x3" size or 2"x2" squares.
- **X** Create a hidden flap off the right or bottom edge of your page by creating a paper hinge and taping it to the back of your base layout. This flap will create an extended canvas for you to place additional photos, journaling and embellishments.



balancing multiple photos

The roomy canvas of a two-page spread affords a scrapbooker the opportunity to load up on photos, but how do you avoid having your photos compete with one another? Nancy had a great solution that she employed on her double layout.


When you look at the sketch, you see that there is one focal photo, two primary photos, and five small supporting photos. Nancy went through her pictures and chose her three favourite shots of her adorable son on Christmas morning. These photos emphasize her journaled story, while the remaining small photos across the bottom of her page play a supporting role. She even added a sixth photo in place of a scrap of paper. Remember this trick the next time you have eight or more photos you'd like to include on a page.


make it in an evening

Scrapbookers want to make the most of their creative time, including our designer, Emily. She employed several tricks to finish her holiday layout in one evening. Rather than border punching, she hand-tore the edge of her journaling strip. She trimmed her photos past the edge of the image to create a faux white mat. Finally, she used preprinted embellishments to reinforce her theme. These few time-saving efforts allowed her to add machine-stitching and still wrap up the layout in one night.

time-saving tips

- **#** Before you begin creating, plan out several layouts at the same time. Print photos, write your journaling and jot down any ideas you have for the page.
- **#** Select coordinating products, such as collection packs, where all of the goods work well together.
- **%** Sketches are a great time-saver because everything is already designed for you. Visit scrapbookandcards. com to download all of our bonus sketches.


pocket scrapbooking tips

- # Low-profile embellishments such as washi tape, stickers, ribbon, preprinted die cuts and thin chipboard elements work best in pocket-styled page sleeves.
- ₩ Repeat design elements in multiple pockets for a cohesive look
- **#** Treat each section of the pocket page protector as a mini canvas. Many of the pockets are the same size, so moving sections around is a breeze.
- # Preprint your photos in a variety of sizes from 4"x6" to 2"x2". From there you can crop to fit each pocket.
- **X** Stamping is a great way to add designs to your pocket page without adding bulk. A date stamp is a great time-saver, too.
- **₩** Mix and match preprinted journaling spots, pocket cards, title inserts and 6"x6" paper pads for a fresh, eclectic look.


pocket scrapbooking

Pocket scrapbooking is quickly gaining in popularity and many manufacturers have their own unique versions of this versatile system. Pocket-style page protectors come in a variety of orientations, offering scrapbookers endless design possibilities.

Lynn commented that she really enjoyed this style of scrapbooking, sharing that, "the page came together in no time at all and the hardest part was deciding what preprinted elements to use, since there were so many to choose from!" She went on to say, "I repeated a few patterns and elements on both pages to unify the theme and design of my page." The results are fantastic!







using 6"x6" paper pads

Coveted by cardmakers, 6"x6" paper pads are equally useful for scrapbooking, providing scrapbookers with mini sheets of complete collections. Because the patterns are more condensed, Lisa was able to use eight papers from one paper pad without her page looking too busy. The smaller pad was also handy for creating die cut elements with little waste. Lisa's page proves that wonderful designs can come from small packages! SCT

6"x6" paper pad tips

- ₩ To create a 12" border strip, trim two same-sized strips, adhere them to your page side-by-side, and hide the seam with an embellishment or photo.
- ₩ Die cut and paper punch smaller elements from your paper pads to avoid cutting into a full 12"x12" sheet of patterned paper.

One of the best things about scrapbooking is that there is something for everyone! Some days I might feel like creating a quick project so I can document a special event. Other times, I find myself in the mood to design embellishments, stitch on my pages or use my electronic die cutter. You can see from the pages I've created here that no matter which style you choose, you can make a layout that is just right for you.





i will love you

supplies CARDSTOCK, Bazzill Basics, PATTERNED PAPER, STICKERS, ENAMEL DOTS, My Mind's Eye; MEASURING TAPE, Maya Road; PEN, Zig; ADHESIVE, Xyron, Scrapbook Adhesive by 3L

With the help of premade embellishments, my easy page came together effortlessly. I matted my photos onto a piece of striped, patterned paper and added a strip of measuring tape below them. Prestitched dimensional stickers added visual interest to my page without the extra work of sewing them myself. I hand-cut hearts to highlight the Valentine's Day theme and applied them with dimensional adhesive. Scattered enamel dots round out my page.



For my detailed page, I maintained the same general design as my easy layout, but added additional layers of patterned paper and a doily under the photos. I hand-cut the title frame from a pocket title card and paired it up with a small tag. I attached strips of patterned paper below the measuring tape to add weight to the bottom half of the page. I painted a few chipboard hearts with acrylic paint and embellished them with enamel dots. For added dimension, I attached the remainder of my embellishments with foam adhesive.

For my expert layout, I went all out on the design. I used the leftover frame from the title card and sandwiched confetti between two layers of vellum behind the frame opening. Using an electronic die cutter, I cut out my title words and layered them over the vellum pocket. After painting my chipboard pieces with acrylic paint, I added Glossy Accents for some extra shine. Clusters of enamel dots finish my page.


When I began scrapbooking back in late 2002, I never really imagined the impact it would have on all areas of my life-personal, professional, financial and emotional.

One of the biggest blessings that scrapbooking has provided me has been the opportunity to not only document my wonderful everyday life but to have an outlet to explore my feelings and emotions as well. Creating layouts that include reflections of where I have been, where I am right now and where I intend to go next has enriched my life in ways I'm not sure I could ever really explain with words.



Scrapbooking is my creative pursuit and my tool for personal expression. It's my passion! I learn new things all the time through the process of recording my own personal journey, which includes life's celebrations as well as its challenges. I reflect. I take stock. I compare and contrast. I document intentions. I look ahead with hope.

The awesome thing about scrapbooking is that it doesn't have to be solely about life's events, kids and holidays. It can be much more about sharing who

layout ideas

- Use a full-page photo as the foundation for your layout, choosing one that has a lot of open or "white" space to fit your journaling onto.
- 2 Machine-stitch lines for your journaling. You can do this before or after you record your intentions. Cluster a few embellishments together and incorporate them into the journaling by stitching them down.
- 3 Hand-write your intentions directly onto the photo using a permanent pen or white gel pen. Try mixing the two.
- 4 Use washi tape to create a textured border around your layout, either on all four sides or just the top and bottom as I've done here.

meditation, a process by which scrapbooking the real pieces of our lives allows us to listen to our inner messages more clearly.

These reflective layouts are often more freeform than my typical graphically-organized pages. That is my goal—to get messy, to be free, to let go of the fine lines, to embrace what is real right now, and to get things out of my head and my heart and onto a page.

idea 1: intentions

I believe in the power of setting intentions. These are often actions that I plan to take, ways I want to live, the person I want to embrace and the individual I wish to become. The act of writing out my intentions releases them into the world around me and makes them more "real." I like to look at them as a path forward, like a roadmap of what's to come in the next year.

To create my own list of intentions for 2014, I began each sentence with the words

I've found that repetition is useful in getting to the heart of what I want to communicate because it encourages me to write more.

Creating a list of intentions does not have to start with the New Year. Anytime you need to check in with yourself and clarify where you would like to be and what you would like to be focusing on is a good time to create a layout that includes those intensions

idea 2: be calm


Sometimes I come across a quote that really speaks to me and where I am in my own personal journey. I keep a list of these quotes on my computer so I can refer back to them for projects or simply to read through them when I need some positive inspiration.

When I really want to understand the words and their meaning to me or simply wish to let them sink in more, I use them on a scrapbook page, either as my main journaling or as a supplement to the story I am telling. The process of creating the page and working with the quote is therapeutic. There is definitely value in combining thoughtfulness and reflection with getting messy with paints and pens.

For this layout, I paired a hand-drawn quote with a 4"x6" photo, then added journaling around the border of the page, explaining why this quote is important to me personally.

lavout ideas

- Pair a 4"x6" photo with a 4"x6" quote card to represent a feeling you wish to capture with both words and a photo. In my layout, I cut a 4"x6" piece of cardstock and hand-wrote my quote on the card.
- 2 Add a cardstock border around the edges of your page and include additional journaling about why this was important enough for you to take the time to create something around it. Give it context.
- 3 Using a permanent pen, add even more words to your printed photo.

idea 3: open wider

For many years now, I have selected one word at the start of each year to be my "one little word" for the next 12 months. Each month I do a simple creative project (either writing, photography or art journaling) as a way to stay in touch with my "one little word." Having a single word to focus on, one that often times has many different threads to tug on, has been transformative for me in my life's journey.

the 3 is

This layout is a great example of using scrapbooking as an opportunity for reflective journaling. When I write like this I include topics such as where I'm at in my life right now, what I'm struggling with, what's going well, and how I want to move forward. Try it and I think you will find that it is a productive and meaningful way to let some of that stuff out of your head and out of your heart.

Scrapbooking can be so much more than recording life's events. It can be an opportunity for reflection and meditation. It can be therapeutic for the heart, the mind and the soul. I encourage you to give it a try.

- Allow yourself to get a little messy and let go of what you think it is supposed to look like. Embrace the final product, whatever it is, as part of the process of growth.
- 3 Draw journaling lines on top of your background as a home for your words.
- 4 Create a border around your page by cutting a piece of cardstock about .75" smaller than your background. Layer that on top of your patterned paper background and paint or spray mist with ink to create your border.

you warm my heart

- 1 Make a 5"x7" card from kraft cardstock, with the opening on the right.
- 2 Center snowflake background die onto front flap of card and die-cut two separate rows. Trim slate blue patterned paper to 5"x7" and adhere to the inside front cover of the card.
- 3 Die cut a 3.25"x4.25" postage stamp from wood-grain paper. Center and adhere to front of card with dimensional adhesive.
- 4 Trim or cut out a pre-printed journal card. Layer a polka-dotted paper bookplate onto the journal card, centered. Hand-stitch into place with ecru twine.
- 5 Die cut a smaller postage stamp from kraft snowflake paper. Adhere to center of bookplate with dimensional adhesive, then adhere sentiment as shown.
- 6 Using kraft ink, stamp three snowflake images onto blue patterned paper. Die cut stamped images using coordinating dies. Adhere to top right, center left and bottom center of the main image, as shown.
- 7 Punch .5" heart from kraft cardstock and adhere to bottom right of the sentiment with dimensional adhesive.
- 8 Finish three kraft buttons with ecru twine and adhere to centers of snowflakes.

supplies CARDSTOCK, DIES, STAMPS, INK, BUTTONS, My Favorite Things; PATTERNED PAPER, Authentique; ADHESIVES, Therm-O-Web, Scrapbook Adhesives by 3L, Sookwang, Beacon; OTHER, twine

merry christmas

- 1 Make a 4.25"x5.5" card from red cardstock, with the opening on the bottom.
- 2 Trim a 4.25''x5'' piece from blue patterned paper. Center and adhere to card front.
- 3 Trim a 3.5"x4.25" piece from green cardstock. Trim a 4.125" x 3.25" piece from red cardstock and adhere to the center of the green piece.
- 4 Cut snowman motif to 3.125"x4" and adhere to center of red mat. Attach assembly to center of blue patterned paper.
- 5 Die cut "snowy tree" scene from white music note paper. Apply iridescent glitter to trees as shown, then adhere to bottom of snowman motif with dimensional adhesive.
- 6 Die cut two snowflakes from blue patterned paper and attach to top right and bottom left of the snowman motif as shown. Attach gem to center of each snowflake.
- 7 Using red Swiss-dot ribbon, tie a small bow. Attach bow below snowflake with fabric glue.
- 8 Cut length of green/white paper straw to the same width as the tree die-cut and adhere with quick-drying adhesive.

- 1 Make a 4.25" x5.5" card from kraft cardstock, with opening on the right.
- 2 Trim a 3.75"x5.5" piece from green gingham paper. Adhere to card, centered.
- 3 Trim a 3"x5.5" piece from wood-grain paper.
- 4 Using a scallop border die, cut two strips from red wood-grain paper. Adhere strips lengthwise to the back of the brown wood-grain piece and trim off excess. Center and adhere entire assembly to green gingham piece, using dimensional adhesive.
- 5 Trim or die cut a green journaling block. Center toward bottom of brown patterned paper, as shown, and adhere with dimensional adhesive
- 6 Add chipboard tag to top of journal block. Attach holly leaves around the hole of the tag. Finish red button with jute. Add small clothespin and adhere button to holly leaves as shown.
- 7 Add chipboard sentiment to the center of the tag and chipboard photo corner to the bottom
- 8 Finish a small red button with jute and adhere to top of photo corner.

- 1 Make a 5"x7" card from textured white cardstock, with opening on the right.
- Trim a 4.75"x6.75" piece from green cardstock.
- Trim a 4.25"x6.25" piece from snowflake patterned paper. Center and adhere to green cardstock piece. Zig-zag stitch around perimeter. Center assembly and adhere to card front
- 4 Cut a 3"x4" oval from green cardstock. Adhere pom-pom trim to the back edge with fabric glue then adhere to center of snowflake paper, using dimensional adhesive.
- 5 Cut a 2.75" x 3.75" oval from diagonal striped paper. Using black ink, stamp snowman image onto striped oval piece. Adhere to center of green oval with dimensional adhesive.
- 6 Using black ink, stamp snowman image onto white cardstock. Colour as desired with watercolour pencils. Fussy cut snowman image and adhere to striped oval piece as shown, using dimensional adhesive.
- Attach green button to snowflake button with white twine. Adhere to bottom left corner of green oval. Tuck sentiment sticker under right edge of the button as shown and adhere.
- 8 Stamp "joy" sentiment onto tab sticker and adhere to the top of green oval with dimensional adhesive.

- 1 Make a 4.25"x5.5" card from kraft cardstock, with the opening on the right. Dry emboss a dot pattern on the front flap of the card.
- 2 Trim a 1.75" x5.5" piece of small print, red/blue patterned paper. Dovetail bottom of the strip to create a banner shape. Center and adhere to card with dimensional adhesive.
- 3 Die cut heart doily motif from blue woodgrain patterned paper. Reserve three small hearts. Die cut a 2.5" circle from small dotted blue/red patterned paper and attach to center of doily. Zig-zag stitch around perimeter.
- 4 Punch three 1.25" hearts from kraft cardstock. Arrange in a vertical row as shown and zig-zag stitch in place. Attach doily shape to top center of banner with dimensional adhesive.
- 5 Attach two small pink crochet hearts to the top left and bottom right of the kraft hearts.
- 6 Using dimensional adhesive, attach three small blue hearts as shown. Add a small blue pearl to the center of each heart.
- 7 Die cut 'happy' from red wood-grain paper and adhere to the center of the bottom right crochet heart with fabric glue.
- 8 Attach sentiment sticker to the right side of the top left crochet heart with dimensional adhesive. Finish a button with white twine and attach to center of crochet heart.
