



LAYOUT 5

Hangin' at Home

SUPPLIES: Design B & Design C Page Protectors, Project Life Hi Sunshine Value Kit, White Bazzill Cardstock, Simple Stories Wood Veneer, Echo Park Chipboard Accents, Adhesive, Corner Rounder, Font: Remington Noiseless & Wisdom Script

- 1 Place B Page Protector on the left and Design C Page Protector on the right. Spines should be touching and in the middle.
- 2 Print six, 4 x 3 photos and place in Design B Page Protector as shown.
- 3 Print one enlarged 12 x 12 photo. Cut into six, 4 x 6 landscape pieces and place in the pockets as shown.
- 4 Select three, 4 x 6 Project Life Title cards with the cloud pattern and place in the top of the page protectors as shown. Select one, 4 x 6 Project Life journaling card, with orange stripe & arrows, cut out stripe and arrows. Adhere orange stripe to third title card as shown. Adhere various coloured arrows to first title card as shown.
- 5 Using the white Bazzill cardstock & wisdom script font, cut the words "hangin @ home" using an electronic cutter. Adhere the words on the first title card, and place in the page protector as shown.
- 6 Using white Project Life journaling card, write journaling with pen or type up on computer using Remington Noiseless font and print. Cut journaling into stripes and adhere on the third title card. Place the card in page protector as shown.
- 7 Select three Simple Stories wood veneer shapes. Place the star wood veneer on the first title card, the label wood veneer on the third title card and the "xoxo" wood veneer at the bottom of the enlarged photo as shown. Select the "relax" Echo Park orange chipboard accent and place on the enlarged photo as shown.



LAYOUT 6

Life with Two

SUPPLIES: Design C & Design F Page Protectors, Project Life Hi Sunshine Value Kit, Simple Stories Wood Veneer, Echo Park Vacation Time Pattern Paper, Doodlebug Stickers, Adhesive

- 1 Cut Design F Page Protector in half, making sure not to touch the seam. Place Design C Page Protector on the left side and Design F Page Protector on the right side, in front of you. Spines should be touching and in the middle.
- 2 Print one enlarged 12 x 12 photo. Cut into six, 4 x 6 landscape pieces and place in Design C Page Protector as shown.
- 3 Select one 4 x 6 white Project Life journaling card. Adhere the "life" wood veneer on to card and the words "with two" using the Doodlebug stickers. Place the journaling card into Design F Page Protector as shown.
- 4 Select two, orange 3 x 4 Project Life filler cards into pockets as shown.
- 5 Select two, orange 3 x 4 Project Life journaling cards. Write journaling with pen or type up on computer using Remington Noiseless font and print. Embellish journaling by placing Doodlebug Stickers on top of journaling cards. Place the cards into page protector as shown.
- 6 Using the Echo Park "Vacation Time" pattern paper, cut out words "happiness is" and "soak it all up". Select two wood veneers. Place both items on top of photo as shown.



DESIGN TIP: It can be hard to create a visual triangle using pocket pages. Place repeating embellishments, like wood veneers, onto of photos to help direct the reader's eye.

LAYOUT 1

Canada Day 2015

SUPPLIES: Design D Page Protectors, Project Life Hi Sunshine Value Kit, Echo Park Bikini Season, Light Pink / Dark Blue and Pink / Blue Pattern, Vacation Time Paper, Echo Park Chipboard Accents, Doodlebug Skinny Stickers, White Bazzill Cardstock, Adhesive, Corner Rounder, Font: Remington Noiseless & Wisdom Script

- 1 Place Design D page protector in front of you. Spine should be on the left.
- 2 Print four, 4 x 6 Portrait Photos and slip into pockets along the outer edges, as shown.
- 3 Select one, 3 x 4 red Project Life card. Write journaling with pen or type up on computer using Remington Noiseless font and print. Place the card in page protector as shown.
- 4 Cut one landscape 3 x 4 card from each of the following pattern papers: Echo Park Bikini Season, Echo Park Light Pink / Dark Blue and Echo Park Pink / Blue. Round corners with corner rounder.
- 5 Select the pail & shovel from Echo Park Chipboard Accents and place on top of the Bikini Season card. Place the card in page protector as shown.
- 6 Using the white Bazzill cardstock and wisdom script font, cut the word "Canada" using an electronic cutter. Using the Doodlebug Skinny Stickers, select letter to spell "Day". Adhere the words on the Echo Park Pink / Blue card and place in the page protector as shown.
- 7 Using scissors, cut the words "Sunshine", "Splash" and "So Happy" from the Echo Park Vacation Time pattern paper. Adhere to the Echo Park Light Pink / Dark Blue paper and slip into page protector as shown.



DESIGN TIP: Look to your photos and products for inspiration. I choose four colours to work with: red, white, blue and dark blue. By limiting my color scheme, I created color harmony on my page.



LAYOUT 2

Family of Three

SUPPLIES: Design D & A Page Protectors, Project Life Hi Sunshine Value Kit, Echo Park Vacation Time, Simple Stories Wood Veneer, White Bazzill Cardstock, Adhesive, Corner Rounder, Font: Remington Noiseless & Wisdom Script

- 1 Place D Page Protector on the left and Design A Page Protector on the right. Spines should be touching and in the middle.
- 2 Print four, 4 x 6 Portrait Photos, one 6 x 12 Portrait photo and two, 4 x 6 Landscape photos and place in page protectors as shown.
- 3 Select one, green 3 x 4 Project Life filler card. Adhere the wood veneer ampersand to card and place in Design A page protector as shown.
- 4 Select one green 3 x 4 Project Life journaling card. Write journaling with pen or type up on computer using Remington Noiseless font and print. Place the card in page protector as shown.
- 5 Cut one 4 x 3 card from the Echo Park Vacation Time /yellow pattern paper. Using scissors, cut the words "celebrate" from the Echo Park Vacation Time paper. Adhere word to the Echo Park yellow paper and slip into page protector as shown.
- 6 Select one, yellow, 4 x 3 Project Life journaling card. Write journaling with pen or type up on computer using Remington Noiseless font and print. Place the card in page protector as shown.
- 7 Select one green 4 x 3 Project Life journaling card. Using the white Bazzill cardstock & wisdom script font, cut the words "family of three" using an electronic cutter. Adhere the words on the Project Life card and place in the page protector as shown.
- 8 Cut one 4 x 3 filler card from the Echo Park "Celebrate" pattern paper. Adhere three wood veneer hearts and place in page protector as shown.



DESIGN TIP: In place of an oversized photo, use three, 4 x 6 landscape photos or six, 3 x 4 portrait photos instead!



LAYOUT 3

Introducing Sam

SUPPLIES: Design A & Design E Page Protectors, Project Life Hi Sunshine Value Kit, Echo Park Papers: Dark Blue, Blue, Vacation Time, Kite Flying, Celebrate Summer, Ice on a Stick; Simple Stories Wood Veneer, Echo Park Chipboard Accents, Echo Park Enamel Dots, Doodlebug Stickers, Fuse Tool, Adhesive, Font: Remington Noiseless & Wisdom Script

- 1 Place Design A Page Protector on the left and Design E Page Protector on the right.
- 2 Print four, 4 x 6 landscape photos and eight, 2.75 x 2.75 square photos. Place in the Design A & E page protectors as shown.
- 3 Select two green 4 x 6 Project Life journaling cards. To make a title card, use an electronic cutter to cut title out of Echo Park Light Blue paper. Adhere title, two blue enamel dots and star wood veneer on to card as shown. Using second journaling card, write journaling with pen or type up on computer using Remington Noiseless font and print. Place the cards as shown.
- 4 Cut eight, 2.75 x 2.75 pieces of paper: one green Project Life filler card; three pieces from the "Dark Blue" paper; one from "Blue" paper; one from the "Kite Flying" paper, one from the "Ice on a Stick" and one from the "Celebrate Summer".
- 5 Cut three 2.5" x 2.5" pieces of paper from the following colour of Project Life filler & journaling cards: blue, green & white. Adhere these smaller pieces to the 2.75 x 2.75 "Dark Blue" squares.
- 6 Arrange photos and paper pieces in check board pattern on top of Design E page Protector as shown.
- 7 Embellish 2.75" x 2.75" squares. Using the "Vacation Time" paper, cut out the following sayings with scissors: "Let's Do This", "Adventures", & "Take a pic". Adhere sayings to similar colour squares. Adhere the camera wood veneer to the "Celebrate Summer" square, while attaching the heart wood veneer to the "Ice on a stick" square. Using the green "hello" chipboard accent, attach to the "Dark Blue" square.
- 8 Using the fuse tool to create twelve, 3x3 pockets in the Design E Page Protector, slipping photos and paper pieces into pockets.



LAYOUT 4

The Purple Playground

SUPPLIES: Design E & Design B Page Protectors, Project Life Hi Sunshine Value Kit, Echo Park Papers: Dark Blue, Blue, Vacation Time, Kite Flying, Bikini Season, Ice on a Stick; Simple Stories Wood Veneer, Echo Park Chipboard Accents, Echo Park Enamel Dots, Doodlebug Stickers, Fuse Tool, Adhesive, Font: Remington Noiseless & Wisdom Script

- 1 Place Design E Page Protector on the left and Design B Page Protector on the right.
- 2 Print three, 4x6 portrait photos and one, 6 x 12 photo or eight, 2.75 x 2.75 photos. Place in the Design E & B page protectors.
- 3 Select six, 3x4 Project Life cards including three matching filler cards and three matching journaling cards. Adhere wood veneer butterfly and "Have Fun" chipboard accent to one filler card. Write journaling with pen or type up on computer using Remington Noiseless font and print. Place in Design B Page Protector as shown.
- 4 Cut eight, 2.75 x 2.75 pieces of paper: two Project Life filler cards; two from the "Pink/Dark Blue" and "Light Pink/Blue" paper; one from "Bikini Season" paper, and "Ice on a Stick".
- 5 Embellish 2.75 x 2.75 squares. Using the "Vacation Time" paper, cut out the pink "Happiness" saying. Adhere this and an arrow wood veneer to the Echo Park "Pink Square" as shown. Select the "Summer Time" chipboard accent & a camera wood veneer, adhering both to the "Dark Blue" square. Place all squares in Design E page protector as shown.
- 6 Using the fuse tool to create twelve, 3x3 pockets in the Design E Page Protector. Slipping photos and paper pieces into pockets before fusing seams, start from the bottom and work your way up.
- 7 Using the white Bazzill cardstock & wisdom script font, cut the words "the playground" using an electronic cutter. Spell the word "purple" using the blue alphabet stickers. Attach title to the outside of the page protector as shown. Embellish using the enamel dots.
